Call to order: Pres. Baker called meeting to order at 7pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

L. STEIN MADE MOTION TO APPROVE MEETING MINUTES OF 6/20/16. K. RICHARDS MADE 2ND. MOTION PASSED 6-0.

Old Business:

- Sherman and Penn Street: broken pipe project update: 2nd phase of project beginning 1. in June, 2017 will be from Sherman Street to High Street if needed.
- 2. Main Street Bridge: Debris Clean-up: Debris was removed from under the bridge last week. Lester Hauck performed the cleanup which only took one day.
- <u>Library: Shutters</u>: W. Ramsey is still waiting for a new quote on wooden shutters.
- 4. HRI Paving invoice: Council reviewed invoice for milling and paving totaling \$79,406.81. The invoice is about \$300 more than the quote. MBMA is responsible and will reimburse \$13,823.20 for paving due to water damage under the street 2 years ago. Money to pay this invoice will first come from budgeted money in the General Fund and the rest will come from Liquid Fuels fund.

New Business:

- 6. <u>Christmas Light Grant from Waldron Memorial Fund at the First Community Foundation Partnership of Pennsylvania</u>: The boro was granted \$15,000 from the Waldron Memorial Fund at the First Foundation Partnership of Pennsylvania for updating Christmas lights. W. Ramsey asked that the boro contribute another \$5,000 to this grant. \$20,000 will then include 2,100 replaced light bulbs to already existing snowflakes, the purchase of 3 more snowflakes and a sensor that will turn the lights on at dusk and stay on for 6 hours.
- E. MCALEER MADE MOTION TO GRACIOUSLY ACCEPT GRANT FROM THE WALDRON MEMORIAL FUND AT THE FIRST COMMUNITY FOUNDATION PARTNERSHIP OF PENNSYLVANIA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000.00 FOR NEW CHRISTMAS LIGHTS. K. RICHARDS MADE 2ND. MOTION PASSED 7-0.
- E. MCALEER MADE MOTION TO DEPOSIT GRANT CHECK FOR \$15,000 IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND THEN TAKE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$20,000 OUT OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND. E. FEIGLES MADE 2ND. MOTION PASSED 7-0.
- 7. SRO in Montgomery: Chief Dorman asked council for their blessing to continue with talks in Montgomery for the boro to provide a SRO for the 2016-2017 school year. This program will be funded entirely by Montgomery. Council approved continued talks with Mongtomery. The next meeting with the Chief and Montgomery in regard to this matter will take place on July 20th. Council will be updated at next meeting.
- 8. <u>Crossing Guard</u>: Chief Dorman is in need of crossing guards for the upcoming school year. Mr. Dewalt, who was a crossing guard at Main and Lafayette would like to continue at that location but asked if he could volunteer his time instead of it being a paid position. Council approved. Chief will still need 1 more guard.

Additionally, if a topic is not on the Agenda it can not be discussed at that particular meeting. Council is not aware yet if the agendas would need to be advertised as well. If so, that would be a major new expense to budget for. W. Ramsey will keep council informed if this law passes or not.
