The meeting of the Muncy Borough Council was called to order in the Borough Council Chambers at 7:03 P.M. by President Ed Feigles. Followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Old Business

Code Inspection, Inc - 192 properties were tagged with possible violations of the property maintaince code. Code Inspections will re-visit the properties to see if the property owner made the necessary repairs. Letters will be sent to those that have not complied. The letters will allow 30 additional days to comply prior to a violation being issued.

Baker Tilly - After receiving a breakdown of the additional expenses, **Motion** to reluctantly pay was made by Linda Stein and second by Rick Umpstead. Motion passed 6-1 with Buzz Baker voting nay.

Green Street Park – Motion by Ed Feigles to purchase up to \$65,000.00 from Lyons Recreation was second by Linda Stein. The purchases would include a hexagon shape pavilion, benches, picnic tables, trash receptacles and a bike rack. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Green Street Park -Motion by Ed Feigles to purchase from Playworld Systems a PlayGuard Saftey System. The system will not exceed \$14,500.00. Motion was second by Linda Stein. All were in favor. Motion carried.

New Business

Street Light for Buttonwood Lane – The residency of Buttonwood Lane have requested a street light be placed on their road. Currently the street lacks lighting. Bill Ramsey will request to have a street light from Charles Road be repositioned to Buttonwood Lane.

Resiliency Update_ The committees has had several meetings this week with their consultant.

Zoning Ordinance Updates – The revised ordinance is in hands of the Planning Commission and will be passed on to council shortly.

An Executive Session was requested for Personnel reasons. No further action was needed.
