Council Minutes
April 15, 2026

Ed Feigles made a motion to approve the March 18, 2026 Minutes. Ryan Scruggs 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Ed Feigles made a motion to approve the check disbursements and bank balances. George Henry 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick Sutton made a motion to approve Sean Freidof to the Shade Tree Commission. Ed 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Ed made a motion to hire Valerie Long as school crossing guard. Ryan 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick made a motion to approve the MOU with the Federal Government. Ed 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

The Muncy Revitalization Task Force is requesting that the borough write and send a welcome letter to the owners of FarmPlast as they continue to renovate the former Sprouts building for their manufacturing plans. Dick made a motion to approve the request of the task force. George 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Ed made a motion too approve little leagues request on placing a storage shed at the Division Street practice field. Ryan 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick made a motion to designate the New Street lot as a park and spend up to \$3000 to equip it with appropriate outside furniture. Ed 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Ryan made a motion to approve the Traffic Signal Agreement with Lecce Electric. Dick 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

George made a motion to Adopt Resolution 2026-11. Ryan 2nd the motion. The Lycoming County Hazard Mitigation Plan makes the Borough eligible for certain FEMA assistance and grant funding. Motion carried.

Dick made a motion to approve the MOU with WBRA for use of 500 Pepper Street as an impoundment yard. Ed 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Ed made a motion to approve the transfer of 208, 212 and 214 N Market Street to WBRA if approved by FEMA for a pump station and to authorize the borough council president and/or borough manager to sign any and all documentation required for the transfer. Dick 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

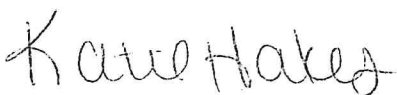
The Carpenter Street bridge has been closed indefinitely after milling in preparation for paving discovered major deterioration of a section of the deck. A review by Livic and PennDOT took place and options on repairs is being prepared with cost estimates for council to consider. A special meeting will take place for council to discuss these options next week.

Public Participation – Bradley Clayton discussed a possibility of putting a banner across Main Street. Solicitor Chris Kenyon explained that would be very unlikely due to it being a PennDOT rd. A banner in the ground at Crossroads Corner would be a better possibility with just council and/or borough managers permission.
