

**MUNCY BOROUGH COUNCIL  
MINUTES  
June 1, 2021**

The meeting of the Muncy Borough Council was called to order in the Borough Fire Department Chambers at 7:00 P.M. by President Ed Feigles. Followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

*Council Members present:* Ed Feigles, Linda Stein(called in), Dana Bertin, Richard Baker, Rick Umpstead, Thad Martin. *Absent:* Scott Delany, Mayor Jon Ort.

*Staff Present:* Boro Manager C. Hall, Police Chief - J. Dorman, and J. Sholtis - Sec/Treas.

*Guest:* Sun-gazette representative John. McCormick Law firm representative Morgan. Selinda Kennedy. SEDA-COG rep - Kristin

**Minutes:** May 4 2021; approved with corrections on a motion by D Bertin, seconded by R. Umpstead. The motion carried 6-0.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Treasurer J Sholtis reported May expenditures and bank balances. L Stein motioned to accept the Treasurers Report. Second by T. Martin all were in favor. Motion carried. 6-0

**Old Business:**

New facility. – No report provided. Solicitor Chris is working on a annexation agreement.

Oil Spill invoice. The invoice has been paid but per DEP the absorption sock is to remain. Morgan from McCormick Law will check on the status of acquiring reimbursement.

Library Engineering RFP: Kristin reported that 4 quotes were received for library renovations. She recommends Hunt EAS from Towanda Pa for \$11,300. A motion by E Feigles and 2<sup>nd</sup> by R Umpstead. The motion also included for boro manager C Hall the ability to execute future library renovation processes.

**New Business:**

Security cameras: J Dorman contacted two companies regarding security cameras for Waldron Park. One of the companies came out and looked at the site and will give us a quote for the next meeting.

Carpenter Street bridge project: C Hall reported a retaining wall on the lower side of Glade Run at 101 Carpenter street is collapsing. A representative from LTAP estimates the costs of relacing the retain wall to be from \$21,000 to \$30,000. More details forthcoming.

Meeting Dates: A discussion was held regarding meeting dates for June and July. The next Council meeting will be July 15<sup>th</sup>. There will not be meetings on June 17 and July 6. Notices will be posted on the boro hall and fire company doors.

**Individual Council members:** R Baker reported that there will be Waldron Foundation monies available for further park upgrades such as lights and benches.

**Borough Resident** - Selinda Kennedy reported that there is a old car on blocks in the yard in the N Market st area. L Stein reported that if one walks the alleys of the borough there are many abandoned vehicles. A discussion ensued. The Muncy police and Codes Inc will do a 'abandoned vehicle' sweep in the borough.

**Borough Reports**

*Borough Manager* – C Hall is working thru a report to obtain \$2,300 of shade tree funding. He is also trying to obtain reimbursement for the wood chipper expense. He updated Council on the Waldron park and plans to fill hole #1 with the dirt from hole #2 once a holding wall is in place.. There are safety zone requirements associated with any play structure. We will be acquiring more mulch.

*Police Department* – Chief Dorman provided the May report to Council.

*Fire Department* - no report provided.

*Public Works* – no written report provided.

*Streets Department* – no written report provided.
