Minutes May 16 2023 – S Delany motioned to accept. S Shank 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Treasurer Reports: J Sholtis presented cash disbursements for approval. S Shank motioned to approve the reports. S Delany 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

Aerial photo – S Delany motioned to purchase a aerial photo of the borough for \$245. S Shank 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

West Branch COD paving bid - S Shank motioned to approve and accept the COG paving bid with Big Rock paving for the Muncy borough paving project for 2023. S Delany 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Fire police resolution #2023-02 – C Hall presented a resolution which allows the fire chief to dispatch the fire police for non-emergency events. Notice will then be given to the police chief and /or the boro manager. This is mainly a workers comp issue. L Stein motioned the resolution. S Shanknd the motion.

County Aid application – J Sholtis presented the County aid application for 2023 in the amount of \$2,140. The funds are used each year to supplement paving projects. L Stein motioned to accept the application. B Scott 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Waldron Park parking expansion – C Hall reviewed a plan to expand parking. Millings will used at the south end of the parking lot. During ball games cars are parking everywhere. B Scott motioned to accept the parking expansion. S Delany 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

FEMA lot liability waiver – S Williams presented a ~~Resolution for a~~ waiver of liability for use of premises after closing. The property is 100 Mechanic street. Allowing the resident to stay in the home for one week. The closing date is June 13th. S Delany motioned to accept the waiver. B Scott 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

FEMA agent appointment – C Hall presented Resolution #2023-03. This resolution appoints Kelsey Green as the authorized agent for closing FEMA buyouts for 100 Mechanic and 119 N Washington streets. S Shank motioned to accept the resolution. S Delany 2nd the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Borough manager – a get well card will be sent to Buzz. The sale of the old fire station is set for June 29th. Charley will inquire about the Muncy river boat launch status. Charley also reported on the garage doors at the maintenance shed which were discussed at the May 25th council meeting. It will cost less than \$7,500 to replace both doors.

IPMC J Lyons – reported on ‘walkaway’ properties in the borough. Borough employees will mow the 107 Division street property. J Lyons reported that the issue is grass only. It is becoming a health and safety issue. J Lyons will email council a list of the other four foreclosures in the borough.

President B Scott thanked the fire and police departments for their participation and assistance in the Memorial Day parade. The borough had a tremendous parade this year and a big turnout.
