MINUTES
March 17, 2023

The meeting of the Muncy Borough Council was called to order in the Borough Hall 6:03 P.M. by President B Scott. The Pledge of Allegiance followed and a moment of silence for Armed Forces, First Responders and Front-Line workers by President B Scott.

Marco Colbert presented research on how FEMA claims are handled in other States. Three out of the four property owners were present for the meeting.

Charley would like to add a 5 minute time limit back to the agenda for public participation procedure. B Scott made a motion to change the 5 minute limit to 3 minutes. Scott Delany made a 2nd motion. All carried 6-0

The Memorial Day parade approval letter was removed from the agenda. This was approved last meeting.
