Council Minutes  
March 18, 2026

The meeting of the Muncy Borough was called to order in the Library/Media Center of the Muncy High School at 6:30pm by President Scott Delany. Followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Borough Manager Report:**

Next meeting, action by Resolution will need to take place to sign on to the County's Hazardous Mitigation Plan. The Shade Tree Commission is planning an Arbor Day event on April 25<sup>th</sup> at Waldron Park.

Delivery date for the poles for the Green Light Go project will be April 14<sup>th</sup>. Their completion date is May 16<sup>th</sup>. The boroughs reimbursement submittal's need to be done before that date.
