

Muncy Borough
Council Minutes
November 19, 2025

The meeting of the Muncy Borough Council was called to order in the Library/Media Center of the Muncy High School at 6:30pm by President Scott Delany followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for First Responders, Armed Forces and Front-Line workers. Also, a moment of silence for Buzz Baker who served on council for many years, and Jim Bishop who served on the Muncy Borough Water Authority.

Charley asked council to add item #9 Handicapped parking to the agenda. Motion made by Dick Sutton and 2nd by George Henry. All in favor.

Tara Ashby made a motion to approve the October 15, 2025 minutes. Ryan 2nd the motion. All were in favor.

Dick Sutton made a motion to approve the check disbursements and bank balances. Tara Ashby 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Old Business – Borough building

CFA met yesterday and decided to defer awarding of LSA grants until their December meeting.

New Business:

George Henry made a motion to approve the Condolence Resolution 2025-11 in memory of Richard C Baker. Thad Martin 2nd the motion. Motion carried. Charley Hall read the Resolution aloud.

Scott Delany made a motion to donate \$250 to the Muncy VFW and \$250 to the Muncy Legion in memory of Buzz Baker to assist Veterans in need. Ryan 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick Sutton made a motion to approve LSA Resolution 2025-12. Ryan Scruggs 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Tara Ashby made a motion to approve the LST Contract. Thad Martin 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Thad made a motion to appoint Craig Scruggs to MBMA with term expiring 12/31/27. Ryan 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Additionally, with the passing of Jim Bishop whose term expires December 2025, MBMA requested council appoint a new member now to cover the last month and the new 5 year term. Tara gladly made a motion to appoint Ed Feigles. Dick 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Ryan made a motion to hire Skyanne Moore as crossing guard. George 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick Sutton made a motion to pay the invoice to repair the leaf vac which was over the budget amount at \$6,975.33. Tara 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Resident Dale Harris, South Washington Street, requested a handicapped parking spot in front of his residence. Mr. Harris will pay for the sign and everything needed to have the sign installed. Chris will then install the sign and paint the curb blue. Dick made a motion to approve the sign. George 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Charley went over the budget document and reasons for a projected surplus. George Henry made a motion to advertise the no tax increase 2026 budget. Ryan 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Announcements:

Borough Manager – Retaining wall for Carpenter Street bridge should be finished by Dec 1. The project will continue in the Spring. PennDot has signed off on the final design for the Muncy Pedestrian Crosswalks. Livic believes we should delay bidding until we have a closer date on when Greenlight Go Project will restart. Leaf Pick up is going well and will continue for a few more weeks. Christmas lights are going up the Sunday after Thanksgiving.

Police Chief was able to get a donation to get an additional tablet for a cruiser.

Scott Delany congratulated 2026 Mayor Craig Scruggs on winning the election.
