

MUNCY BOROUGH COUNCIL
MINUTES
October 5, 2021

The meeting of the Muncy Borough Council was called to order in the Borough Fire Department Chambers at 7:00 P.M. by President Ed Feigles. Linda led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Staff Present: Boro Manager C. Hall, Police Chief - J. Dorman.

Minutes: September 16 2021; Motion by S. Delany. Second by L Stein. The motion carried 6-0.

Treasurer's Report:

Treasurers report was presented with September expenditures and bank balances. S Delany motioned to accept the Treasurers Report. Second by R. Umpstead all were in favor. Motion carried. 6-0.

Old Business:

New facility – S Delany reported that he is recommending a metal carport in order to get all police and maintenance shed equipment out the weather. J Gramling is to get 3 quotes.

Annexation – E Feigles is to go to a Muncy Creek Township meeting to present a MOU regarding the future possibility of annexation of the maintenance shed area.

Zoning Hearing Board – C Hall reported that EJ Rymysza has resigned. John Konkle is willing to continue serve. We will advertise on the boro web site to replace Mr Rymysza.

New Business:

Boro Budget 2021-22 - C Hall presented the 2021 projection and 2022 draft budget as prepared by the Treasurer.

Borough Right-of-ways – a discussion was held regarding unused borough right-of ways. C Hall provided examples of alleys and right-of-ways that are unused. The boro will explore, along with McCormick law, the possible closure of the three discussed right-of-ways.

Glade Run patrol - L Stein reported on Glade Run and feels the Japanese knot weed is a problem and contributing to damming and flooding.

New crossing guard – J Dorman is recommending Nicole Dirato is brought on as a substitute crossing guard. E Feigles motioned. R Umpstead 2nd. The motion carried 6-0.

Elem school 5K monster dash – J Droman reported that he has a request from Muncy school district requesting a letter of support from the borough. A approval letter with permission will be submitted as part of permit application. S Delany motioned and D Bertin 2nd. The motion carried 6-0. S Delany motioned to use the fire police if the event is held. E Feigles 2nd. The motion carried 6-0.

Traffic signal maintenance agreement – C Hall reported that he has an agreement with PennDot for traffic signal maintenance. R Umpstead motioned to approve the agreement and include a resolution authorizing a designated signer for all current and further agreements. E Feigles 2nd the motion. The motion carried 6-0.

Borough Manager – Leaf collection will commence November 1st. The Waldron park swings are up.

Police Chief – Brady Township has given the borough \$1,000 to decal the new cruiser.
