

Muncy Borough
Council Minutes
September 17, 2025

The meeting of the Muncy Borough Council was called to order in the Library/Media Center of the Muncy High School at 6:30pm by President Scott Delany followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence for Armed Forces, First Responders, Front-Line workers and a special resident who has attended all of our meetings, Wayne Wolfgang and his wife, who is currently going through troubling times.

Richard Sutton made a motion to approve the September 21, 2025 Minutes. George 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick Sutton made a motion to approve the check disbursements and bank balances. Thad Martin 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Old Business – Borough building

Charley reported a conversation with DCED on a update for those who submitted grant applications. Everything is currently held up for negotiation purposes.

Ryan Scruggs made a motion to approve Resolution #2025-10 – Reducing Employee contributions to the Police Pension Plan 2025-2026. Thad Martin 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick Sutton made a motion to approve the Pension Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) 2026. George Henry 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Ryan Scruggs made a motion to approve Keystone Collections Group to collect Local Service Taxes beginning 2026. Dick Sutton 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Thad Martin made the motion to approve the hiring as Dennis Wertman as a crossing guard. George Henry 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Thad Martin approved Charley Hall to attend the Fall PSAB conference. Ryan Scruggs 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Dick Sutton made a motion to transfer \$5,000 from General Fund to the Shade Tree Fund for tree pruning. Ryan Scruggs 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

Borough Reports:

Borough Manager: Charley informed council we are still waiting on three signed easements for the Main and Penn traffic light. The easement for Carpenter St bridge has been signed and currently waiting for DEP to issue a permit. WBRA will be finishing North Washington Street by the end of the month. The final chipper day will be September 24th. No more chipping will occur after that until the Spring. Leaf Collection will then begin. Charley also made comment on what a wonderful job Chris and Tom have been doing and how busy they have been picking up brush. Council should be very pleased with the dedication and service they provide to Muncy.

Public Participation:

Tyler Thompson commented how beneficial it will be for Keystone to collect Local Service Taxes for the borough. The Agency will know whether the money is being collected properly from different agencies around the borough. Tyler also asked if council could give project updates on Crossroads Corner. Charley explained Crossroads corner is currently at a hiatus. Given the weather, it is not a good time to do any planting they need to do at this time. This project will be completed by December 15th.

Alicia Myers wanted council to be aware that if they ever seen any dangerous trees or limbs, to please let them know. They are their most priority.
